Call for Papers for

Monthly Section Meetings

We invite authors to submit abstracts on topics that advance the art, science and practice of naval architecture and marine engineering in all their applied forms including the construction and operation of ships, marine vehicles, and structures of all kinds.

Instructions for Abstracts:

Authors are requested to submit only electronic abstracts of their proposed papers to the Technical Program Chair. The abstract must include the title of the paper, the preferred topic area, the name, affiliation, full address including phone numbers and email addresses of ALL authors. In the case of multiple authors, please clearly designate the corresponding author. The body of the abstract should not exceed 350 words. Abstracts will be evaluated by a Technical Committee consisting of Chesapeake Section Executive Committee members. Criteria for acceptance includes topical interest to Section members, topic timeliness, technical quality, potential for generating discussion, and author/presenter reputation in topic.

Final Paper and Presentations:

Papers should not exceed 15 pages, and must be written in English. Author instructions can be found on the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers (SNAME) website (http://www.sname.org/author_instructions_authors.htm). Papers will be reviewed before final acceptance. Presentations should not be longer than 30 mins and are preferred in electronic format. Additional audio-visual and/or demonstration materials are encouraged for the technical paper presentation.

Deadline Dates:

Paper submittals are accepted at any time. Although the Section aims to have author commitments for full paper presentations for all meetings in advance of the meeting season (September through the following June), full paper presentations have tended to be an exception recently. Accordingly, authors of full papers – especially of timely topics – are encouraged to submit abstracts at any time. If appropriate, the Section will make adjustments in the technical presentation schedule to accommodate full papers in place of non-paper presentations. Preliminary drafts of papers are due one month prior to presentation date; a final draft is due four days prior to presentation.
